and activities.

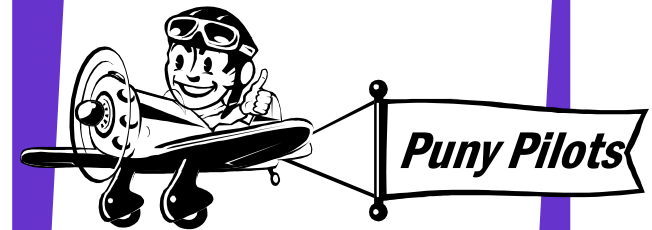

Limit 10 children per session

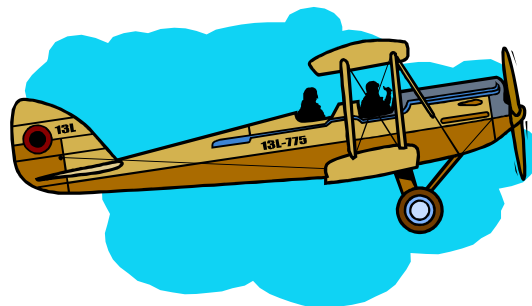
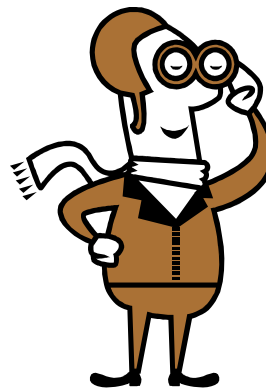
Flying Fun: Ages 3-4

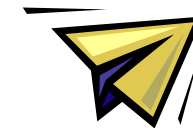
